Show Rules

- 1. Hats to meet current standards, with harnesses properly adjusted and fastened, to be worn at all times when mounted.
- 2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. Everyone on the show ground must obey all instructions from organisers.
- 3. Entries are made at your own risk. No liability can be accepted for accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders or any other person or property however caused.
- 4. Competitors must have third party insurance and are advised to have their horse's passports with them.
- 5. The organisers have the right to alter, merge or cancel classes at their discretion.
- 6. Late entries will only be allowed in the ring if in possession of a late slip.
- 7. Two entry fees are payable for the Family Pony as two rosettes will be awarded.
- 8. The judge's decision is final.
- 9. All complaints must be directed to a show coordinator. Abusive behaviour towards judges or stewards will not be tolerated and will result in the competitor being asked to leave.
- 10. Entry fees cannot be refunded except if the show or the class has to be cancelled.
- 11. Making an entry constitutes acceptance of the rules. No entry will be permitted without payment of the entry fee.
- 12. Dogs must be kept under control on a short lead at all times and are only allowed in pedestrian and parking areas.
- 13. Please keep the showground tidy and take litter home with you.
- 14. No stallions over 2 years old.
- 15. Any horse behaving in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave the field.
- 16. Competitors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 17. Membership will be accepted on the day, and will qualify for reduced entry fees but not best member rosettes.
