

SHOW RULES

- 1. Hats to the current BHS standard with harness secured at 3 points at least must be worn at ALL times when mounted.
- 2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. Everyone on the showground must obey instructions from the organisers.
- 3. Entries are made at your own risk. NO liability can be accepted for accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses/ponies, riders, or any other persons or properties however caused. Competitors must have third party insurance and are advised to have their horses/ponies passports with them.
- 4. The organisers have the right to alter, merge or cancel classes at their discretion.
- 5. The judges decision is final.
- 6. All complaints must be directed to the show coordinator.
- 7. Abusive behaviour towards judges or stewards will not be tolerated and will result in the competitor being asked to leave.
- 8. Entry fees cannot be refunded except if the show or a class has to be cancelled.
- 9. Making an entry constitutes acceptance of the rules and our equine flu policy. No entry will be accepted without payment of entry fee.
- 10. Dogs must be kept on a lead at ALL times. No dogs allowed in the cafe area but are permitted in the viewing gallery provided they do not cause a nuisance to competitors.
- 11. Please keep the showground tidy and take all your litter home with you.
- 12. NO STALLIONS over 2 years old.
- 13. Any horse/pony behaving in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave the field.
- 14. Competitors under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 15. Membership will be accepted on the day and will qualify for reduced entry fee.



Due to the continued outbreaks of equine flu, it is a condition of entering this year's show that you have an up to date flu vaccination.

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and the 2nd vaccinations between 21 and 92 days later). Followed by the first booster (150 - 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the 1st booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

Horses must have been vaccinated within 12 months before the show (since 1st December 2018) but not less than 7 days before the show (before 24th November 2019).

Please ensure you have your horse/pony's ID passport with you as we will be carrying out random checks on the day.

We recommend that all trailers and boxes should be cleaned prior to attending the show to reduce the risk of spreading infection and you should also bring your own water and buckets.

If you cannot present your passport showing up to date vaccinations you may be asked to leave the showground.

Arena 1 -Fun Show Jumping Commences 9am

Classes 2 - 3 shall run as follows

Each jumping fault will be penalised by 4 marks

1. Clear Round - to run 9am - 9.30am (last entries taken at 9.20am) Height of fences not to exceed 45cm Rosette to every clear round



Each competitor to jump the course on foot first then mounted second

max height of fences 45cm

3. Pairs Jumping

Both competitors in each team will jump the same course Max height of fences 60cm


2 entry fees payable

4. Accumulator

Height of fences 50cm - 90cm


60seconds to jump as many jumps as possible. The higher the jump the higher the points value

11. Young Handler




13. Riding Club Horse/Ridden Cob/Hack

Championship to take place in Arena 1










Arena 1 - Ridden To commence no earlier than 12.30pm

Championship to take place in Arena 1






