

# Summer Dressage Points League

July, August & September 2018

Woodnook Arena, Meltham, Holmfirth, HD9 4DU

All classes will start at 6pm. Entries will close at 11pm on the Friday before the show and times will be available after 9am on the Monday before. Late entries may be accepted after this time subject to class availability. No entries will be accepted on the day.

Round	Classes	Cost
1. 25th July	Intro A, Prelim 2, Novice 24, Bitless option for all tests	£10 Members/£12 Non-Members
2. 29th August	Intro B, Prelim 7, Novice 27, Bitless option for all tests	£10 Members/£12 Non-Members
3. 26th September	Intro C, Prelim 18, Novice 28, Bitless option for all tests	£10 Members/£12 Non-Members

## Rules & Allocation of Points

- Tack must confirm to BD rules in all classes excluding the bitless class however bridle/saddle pad numbers are optional.
- Full dressage or light coloured breeches/jodhpurs and show jacket preferred but not essential. Hat up to current standards and correct footwear essential.
- Maximum of two tests per combination per section (bitted/bitless).
- Combinations entering the Intro class may not enter the Novice class in the same round. Once a combination has entered a Novice class they will not be allowed to enter an Intro class in a later round.
- Both Members and non-members are able to earn points.
- Rosettes to 6th in each class each round. Points awarded per class as follows.  
1st - 10 points, 2nd - 9 points, 3rd - 8 points, 4th - 7 points, 5th - 6 points, 6th - 5 points.  
2 points per round per section per combination to be awarded regardless of final position.
- Trophies to all class winners and overall section winners. Rosettes to class and overall section league champions and reserve champions.
- Trophies and League rosettes to be presented at our Annual Presentation Award Dinner on 24th November.
- Competitors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult

## Bitless Class Rules

- Class will be running as a separate class under a separate section.
- Competitors must indicate on their entry form if they are entering the bitless class and confirm on entry which test(s) they will be performing.
- Competitors may enter other classes on the same horse provided they meet the BD tack rules in those classes and will still only be eligible to enter a maximum of two classes per combination per section (bitted/bitless).

**Withdrawals made after the official entry closing date will not be reimbursed if the place cannot be filled.**
